

ALL GROUPS AT HOTA - CHOIRS, BANDS & DANCE GROUPS MUST HAVE TWO DELEGATED MARSHALS FOR EACH GROUP WHO WILL ASSIST IN THE FLOW OF THE COMPETITION AND SUPERVISE ENTERING AND EXITING THEIR PERFORMANCE.

WE WILL REQUIRE A LIST OF ALL PARTICIPANTS FOR EACH GROUP PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

DANCE GROUPS – THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO 'HOLDING' ROOM FOR PARENTS. THIS AREA IS LIMITED TO PERFORMERS, TEACHERS AND DELEGATED MARSHALS. BAGS ARE TO BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

PROPS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO BE USED ACCORDING TO GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS AND MAY BE LIMITED OR RESTRICTED. AT THIS TIME, IT IS ONLY HAND HELD PROPS I.E. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter.
- 2. Entries close: May 7, 2021. To assist the office, please submit entries as early as possible online. Online payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor and an entrant may only enter once in each section unless specified.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded)
- 14. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 15. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones, cameras and video recorders are prohibited in HOTA Arts Theatre. In other venues, private videoing is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage from the Video area. No photographs during a performance.
- 16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.
- 17. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.

- 18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 19. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 21. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 22. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified.
- 23. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GCE on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
- 24. All medals & trophies are provided by the Gold Coast Eisteddfod.
- 25. Competitors must change in their designated area No public area to be used for changing.
- 26. The use of the house curtain is prohibited.
- 27. Props must be free standing and able to be quickly placed on the stage. No props that cause debris ie. talc powder, confetti, glitter or popping of balloons is allowed.
- 28. In duo & trio sections, competitors may perform twice. The oldest performer must enter the relevant age section.
- 29. Music must be uploaded via GCE system prior to event. All competitors must have at least one back up on USB (1 track) or similar device NO CD's. Following the release of the program you will be emailed instructions on how to upload your music.
- 30. Should a competitor (12 years & over) leave the stage as a result of having forgotten their routine, they may be permitted to reappear.
- 31. No microphones to be used in any section.
- 32. No competitor is to perform anywhere other than the stage area. This includes entry, exits and absolutely NO jumping off the stage.
- 33. The age of the competitors for solos, duos and trios will be as at August 1, 2021.
- 34. Entries will not be accepted for competitors outside their age group.
- 35. Any competitor who attends group dance classes for less than 15 hours per week may perform in the sections which have the classification Non full time students
- 36. Inappropriate and suggestive movement, costuming and /or obscene language is not permitted. The Adjudicator may comment and/or penalise.
- 37. Entrants are ineligible if they have received individual tuition from the Adjudicator in the past 6 months (workshop and guest teaching excluded).
- 38. All teachers must collect an identifying pass.

The age of the competitors for solos, duos and trios will be as at August 1, 2021.

PLEASE NOTE CHANGE TO MUSIC FOR 2021 MUSIC WILL BE UPLOADED VIA GCE SYSTEM PRIOR TO EVENT ON COMPLETION OF PROGRAM.

- Rules & Regulations pertaining to each section are outlined in this Syllabus and will not be repeated in the program. Changes to some rules may occur from year to year, therefore it is imperative that all instructions are read carefully. Disqualification may follow if rules are not observed.
- Time limits stated are maximum allowed.
- Health and safety regulations require the Gold Coast Eisteddfod to adhere to rules regarding competitors' safety. In keeping with Child Protection policy all dressers backstage will be required to collect a wrist band from the admission desk in the foyer.
- Cameras are not permitted and mobile phones must be switched off at all times in dressing rooms and backstage areas.
- Competitors must change in dressing rooms and public areas are not be utilised as change rooms.
- No food or drink permitted in dressing rooms apart from bottled water.
- Absolutely no rehearsing in corridors, passageways, on stage or public areas.
- The use of glitter spray and hairspray is a health hazard. These must be used with great care in a well ventilated area preferably in the open air.

DEFINITIONS

ACROBATICS: Acrobatics is a dance with unique choreography which seamlessly

blends dance and acrobatics, and its use of acrobatics in a dance context.

BROADWAY: Most commonly known as broadway jazz, though it may be other styles.

CABARET: A floor show of dancing, singing or other light entertainment.

CLASSICAL BALLET: Must include Classical steps and technique.

CONTEMPORARY: Interpretive dance using balance and control - Contemporary style. **DEMI-CHARACTER:** Classical ballet includes mime, acting, story-telling and is set to music

ENTERTAINMENT: Previously - Variety/Novelty - any style of entertaining dance that does not fall

into any other category.

HIP HOP: Popular, high energetic routine using street styles of dance.

JAZZ: A routine using Jazz technique and appropriate music.

LYRICAL: Slow controlled movement that demonstrates a close connection to and understanding

of the music. Must demonstrate balance, flexibility and control.

MUSICAL THEATRE: A dance item from a Musical – Film or Stage to include live singing (no lip syncing or

vocals on backing track permitted)

NATIONAL: A traditional dance of a country.

OWN CHOREOGRAPHY: Routine must be self-choreographed – costumes permitted.

SONG & DANCE/TAP: Routine must contain both singing & dancing. No vocal backing is permitted whilst

singing, however vocals are permitted whilst dancing.

SLOW/WALTZ TAP: Must be slow tap movements, choreographed to slow/waltz tempo music.

SPEED TAP: Must be speed tap movements choreographed to fast tempo music.

TAP: Any style or tempo of tap.

ANY COMPETITOR WHO ATTEND GROUP DANCE CLASSES FOR LESS THAN 15 HOURS PER WEEK MAY PERFORM IN THE SECTIONS WHICH HAVE THE CLASSIFICATION NON FULL-TIME STUDENTS.

Music must be uploaded via GCE system prior to event. All competitors must have at least one back up on USB (1 track) or similar device – NO CD's. Following the release of the program you will be emailed instructions on how to upload your music.



Entrants are to complete a written application after which one performer from each of the following will be chosen to receive a \$500 grant:

- Dance
- Vocal
- Strings

- Piano
- Speech & Drama

Each winner must then submit an electronic performance to the Gold Coast Eisteddfod to then be submitted to a panel of judges to decide a winner who will receive a further \$1,000 and a runner up a further \$500.
