

DUE TO GOVERNMENT COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE TO BE IN PLACE FOR THIS YEAR'S GCE.

ALL GROUPS AT HOTA - CHOIRS, BANDS & DANCE GROUPS MUST HAVE TWO DELEGATED MARSHALS FOR EACH GROUP WHO WILL ASSIST IN THE FLOW OF THE COMPETITION AND SUPERVISE ENTERING AND EXITING THEIR PERFORMANCE.

WE WILL REQUIRE A LIST OF ALL PARTICIPANTS FOR EACH GROUP PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

DANCE GROUPS – THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO 'HOLDING' ROOM FOR PARENTS. THIS AREA IS LIMITED TO PERFORMERS, TEACHERS AND DELEGATED MARSHALS. BAGS ARE TO BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

PROPS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO BE USED ACCORDING TO GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS AND MAY BE LIMITED OR RESTRICTED. AT THIS TIME, IT IS ONLY HAND HELD PROPS I.E. THE DANCER MUST BE ABLE TO CARRY THE PROP IN THEIR HANDS AND THIS WILL STAY IN EFFECT UNTIL THE PANDEMIC IS LIFTED. (CHAIRS/BENCHES WILL BE ALLOWED AND CAN BE STORED IN THE DOCK - SPECIFIC ARRANGEMENTS AND DELIVERY WILL BE ADVISED PRIOR TO THE EVENT)
