

ALL GROUPS AT HOTA - CHOIRS, BANDS & DANCE GROUPS MUST HAVE TWO DELEGATED MARSHALS FOR EACH GROUP WHO WILL ASSIST IN THE FLOW OF THE COMPETITION AND SUPERVISE ENTERING AND EXITING THEIR PERFORMANCE.

WE WILL REQUIRE A LIST OF ALL PARTICIPANTS FOR EACH GROUP PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

DANCE GROUPS – THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO 'HOLDING' ROOM FOR PARENTS. THIS AREA IS LIMITED TO PERFORMERS, TEACHERS AND DELEGATED MARSHALS. BAGS ARE TO BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter.
- 2. Entries close: May 7, 2021. To assist the office, please submit entries as early as possible online. Online payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor and an entrant may only enter once in each section.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded)
- 14. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 15. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones, cameras and video recorders are prohibited in HOTA Theatre 1. In other venues, private videoing is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage. No photographs during a performance.
- 16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.
- 17. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.

- 18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 19. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 21. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 22. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified.
- 23. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GCE on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
- 24. All medals & trophies are provided by the Gold Coast Eisteddfod.
- 25. All teachers and accompanists excluding those associated with school groups must collect an dentifying pass.
- 26. In solos and duos, the age of the competitors will be as at August 1, 2021.
- 27. Entries will not be accepted for competitors outside their age group.

- Rules & Regulations pertaining to each section are outlined in this Syllabus and will not be repeated in the program. Changes to some rules may occur from year to year, therefore it is imperative that all instructions are read carefully. Disqualification may follow if rules are not observed.
- Time limits stated are maximum allowed.
- A copy of music must be provided for the adjudicator. Photocopies provided will be destroyed by GCE.
- Please contact accompanists immediately if required. A fee will be charged for rehearsal and performance. Accompanists reserve the right to refuse if not contacted at least three weeks prior to session.
- Piano accompaniment only except in sections SWB06 and SWB23, where instrumental backing tracks are permitted.
- All necessary audio equipment must be supplied by the competitor.
- With the exception of championships, one piece or one movement of a work to be played.
- Trios, Quartets/Quintets may play any number of pieces up to the time limit.
- Music which has been written with an accompaniment must be played with an accompanist.
- Competitors cannot play in more than one Grade Section and no more than one Championship.
- Tuning must be completed prior to entering the Auditorium. No on stage tuning.
 THERE MAY BE SOME CHANGES IN DATES AND VENUES SO PLEASE CHECK PROGRAM CAREFULLY WHEN RECEIVED.

GOLD COAST AIRPORT TROPHY will be awarded to a String Instrument Soloist judged to have potential not necessarily a prize winner

Artistic Development Grants

Competitors aged 16 to 20 years as at August 1, 2021 are invited to apply for the Artistic Development Grants if they have won either two solo sections or one championship section in their chosen genre.

Entrants are to complete a written application after which one performer from each of the following will be chosen to receive a \$500 grant:

- Dance
- Vocal
- Strings
- Wind/Brass
- Piano
- Speech & Drama

Each winner must then submit an electronic performance to the Gold Coast Eisteddfod to then be submitted to a panel of judges to decide a winner who will receive a further \$1,000 and a runner up a further \$500.

DEFINITIONS

ACROBATICS/

CHEERLEADING: Acrobatics is a dance with unique choreography which seamlessly blends dance

and acrobatics and its use of acrobatics in a dance context. Cheerleading is a routine that contains components of tumbling, dance, jumps, cheers and stunts.

BROADWAY: Most commonly known as broadway jazz, though it may be other styles.

CABARET: A floor show of dancing, singing or other light entertainment. All performers must be

at least 15 years of age.

CLASSICAL BALLET: Must include classical steps and classical technique.

CONTEMPORARY: Interpretive dance using balance and control - contemporary style. **DEMI-CHARACTER:** Classical ballet includes mime, acting, story-telling and is set to music.

ENTERTAINMENT: Previously known as Variety/Novelty – any style of entertaining dance that does not

fall into any other category.

HIP HOP: Popular, high energetic routine using street styles of dance.

JAZZ: Previously known as up-tempo modern - a routine using jazz technique and

appropriate music.

LYRICAL: Slow controlled movement that demonstrates a close connection to and understanding

of the music. Must demonstrate balance, flexibility and control.

MUSICAL THEATRE: A dance item from a Musical – Film or Stage to include live singing (no lip syncing or

vocals on backing track permitted)

SONG & DANCE/TAP:Routine must contain both singing & dancing and all performers must sing & dance. No

vocal backing is permitted whilst singing, however vocals are permitted whilst dancing.

Style of tap with more relaxed arm lines compared to traditional tap. Focussing on

Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter.
- 2. Entries close: May 7, 2021. To assist the office, please submit entries as early as possible online. Online payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor and an entrant may only enter once in each section unless specified.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded)
- 14. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 15. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones, cameras and video recorders are prohibited in HOTA Arts Theatre. In other venues, private videoing is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage from the Video area. No photographs during a performance.
- 16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.
- 17. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.

- 18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 19. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 21. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.

- 30. Should a competitor (12 years & over) leave the stage as a result of having forgotten their routine, they may be permitted to reappear.
- 31. No microphones to be used in any section.
- 32. No competitor is to perform anywhere other than the stage area. This includes entry, exits and absolutely NO jumping off the stage.
- 33. The age of the competitors for solos, duos and trios will be as at August 1, 2021.
- 34. Entries will not be accepted for competitors outside their age group.
- 35. Any competitor who attends group dance classes for less than 15 hours per week may perform in the sections which have the classification Non full time students
- 36. Inappropriate and suggestive movement, costuming and /or obscene language is not permitted. The Adjudicator may comment and/or penalise.

DEFINITIONS

ACROBATICS: Acrobatics is a dance with unique choreography which seamlessly

blends dance and acrobatics, and its use of acrobatics in a dance context.

BROADWAY: Most commonly known as broadway jazz, though it may be other styles.

CABARET: A floor show of dancing, singing or other light entertainment.

CLASSICAL BALLET: Must include Classical steps and technique.

CONTEMPORARY: Interpretive dance using balance and control - Contemporary style. **DEMI-CHARACTER:** Classical ballet includes mime, acting, story-telling and is set to music

ENTERTAINMENT: Previously - Variety/Novelty - any style of entertaining dance that does not fall

into any other category.

HIP HOP: Popular, high energetic routine using street styles of dance.

JAZZ: A routine using Jazz technique and appropriate music.

LYRICAL: Slow controlled movement that demonstrates a close connection to and understanding

of the music. Must demonstrate balance, flexibility and control.



- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter.
- 2. Entries close: May 7, 2021. To assist the office, please submit entries as early as possible online. Online payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest teachers excluded)
- 14. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 15. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. The use of mobile phones, cameras and video recorders is prohibited in HOTA Theatre 1. In other venues, private videoing is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage. No photographs during a performance.
- 16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.
- 17. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.

- 18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 19. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 21. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 22. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified.
- 23. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GCE on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
- 24. All medals & trophies are provided by the Gold Coast Eisteddfod.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- By entering the Gold Coast Eisteddfod you agree to abide by the rules and regulations as outlined in this 2021 Syllabus. Gold Coast Eisteddfod's public liability does not comprehensively cover injury to performers therefore individuals and schools must ensure that they are adequately covered whilst performing or otherwise enter at their own risk. By agreeing, you automatically grant permission for digital images or photographs to be used for promotional or marketing purposes and/or on social media. If you do not agree, please advise the Eisteddfod office in writing.
- Rules and regulations pertaining to each section are outlined in this Syllabus and will not be repeated in the program. Changes to some rules may occur from year to year, therefore it is imperative that all instructions are read carefully. Disqualification may follow if rules are not observed.
- Time limit is calculated from first note played or 10 seconds after curtain is raised (whichever occurs first) to the last note played including applause between items.
- At the time limit stated, up to 15 seconds may be allowed to conclude the performance after this time, the house curtain may be brought it. It is NOT essential to play up to the time limit.
- Penalties will be applied by the adjudicator if the performance is over the stated time limit.
- Conductors should select the level of repertoire at the recommended level stated for each Grade which will best showcase this in their performance.
- No student taking part in graded sections will be permitted to play in another grade unless playing a different instrument. Percussionists may play in one grade only unless otherwise specified.
- A copy of music must be provided for the adjudicator. Photocopies will be destroyed by GCE.
- No soloists in Concert Band, Orchestra, String Orchestra or Instrument Ensemble sections i.e. No concerto/concerto grosso repertoire.
- To avoid program clashes a conductor must be nominated on entry together with numbers in each ensemble and whether string orchestras are standing or seated.
- To avoid overcrowding on stage or backstage and to facilitate quick changeovers, competitors must use available instruments/equipment where these are provided.

- All electrical requirements, including keyboard, amplifiers and power supplies, need to comply with Queensland Government regulations - i.e. must have current electrical test and tag. Non-compliance will result in the equipment being disallowed.
- For Bands & Orchestras a limit of 70 seated musicians.
- Students must attend the school they represent (unless otherwise stated).
- Directors of groups must arrange for responsible adults with school ID to supervise members inside and outside the theatre.
- Banners will be permitted for front row players only.
- On stage preparation time must not exceed 4 minutes including set up and tuning.
- Competitors must be in their allocated warm up room or allocated seating in the theatre prior to start time of their sections. Performers must stay together as a group for the duration of the session and are not permitted to join parents in the audience seating.
- Instruments or belongings are not be left unattended except in allocated storage areas.
- Teachers please note withdrawals and events beyond the control of the convenor may affect the running time of sections. All reasonable effort will be made to adhere to the program but the order of appearance may be changed without advance notice at the discretion of the convenor. Please advise parents only the section start time not anticipated performance time.
- There may be some changes in dates and venues so please carefully check program when received.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter. Unless specified.
- 2. Entries close: May 7, 2021. To assist the office, please submit entries as early as possible online. Online payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrant, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor and a competitor may only enter once in each section.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded)
- 14. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 15. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones, cameras and video recorders are prohibited in HOTA Theatre 1. In other venues, private videoing is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage. No photographs during a performance.
- 16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.

- 17. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.
- 18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 19. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 21. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 22. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified.
- 23. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GCE on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
- 24. All medals & trophies are provided by the Gold Coast Eisteddfod.
- 25. In duo mime, poem in pairs and duologue sections, competitors may appear twice but with a different partner. In group sections competitors may appear twice only.
- 26. The age of the competitors for solo and duos will be as at August 1, 2021. Group items only (excluding duos and trios), age will be as at January 1, 2021.
- 27. Entries will not be accepted for competitors outside their age group.
- 28. All teachers must collect an identifying pass.


