

ACCESSIBILITY

GLOW - 10 Energy Cct, Robina

HOTA – For wheelchair users and people with mobility requirements there is a ramp that provides access from the street level to the terrace and HOTA Café, and then heading indoors there is a lift which will take you to the main foyer, Box Office and Theatre 1.

Guide Dogs and Assistance/Service Animals - your guide dog or registered assistance/service animal is more than welcome! Just let HOTA know you'll be bringing one when you book your tickets.

Theatre 1 Stage accessibility - whilst there are some challenges that HOTA face due to the age of the venue (ie access via BOH areas) HOTA staff are able to offer access for a range of requirements.

BROADBEACH CULTURAL PRECINCT - Access to Albert Water Ways Auditorium is via the front entrance of the building with no stairs. For access on stage there is a wheelchair lift.

ROBINA COMMUNITY CENTRE - Access to Robina Community Centre Auditorium is via the front entrance of the building with no stairs. For access on stage there is a wheelchair lift.

Access to the multipurpose room's has a ramp and all rooms we use are on the ground floor.

A.B. PATERSON - DAWN LANG PERFORMING ARTS CENTRE -

There is a ramp to provide access from the street level to the theatre entrance. Access into the theatre is from the entrance doors either side of the building, all the same floor level with space available for wheelchairs and mobility aids in the centre row.

GLOW - Is a one level venue and seating in the auditorium is all one level. There is a ramp to access the stage from the auditorium.

ALL GROUPS - DANCE, BANDS & CHORAL - Must have two delegated marshals for each group who will assist in the flow of the competition and supervise entering and exiting their performance.

We will require numbers in group when entering.

ALL Groups – there will be no access to 'holding' room for parents. This area is limited to performers, teachers and delegated marshals. Bags are to be kept to a minimum.

Only hand held props i.e. the dancer must be able to carry the prop in their hands (chairs / benches will be allowed)

ADMINISTRATION FEE

\$10 administration fee is charged and is non-refundable for each invoice/entry - this fee includes the electronic program emailed when completed mid-June.

Entrants are to complete a written application after which one performer from each of the following will be chosen to receive a \$500 grant:


Dance | Vocal | Strings | Wind/Brass | Piano | Speech & Drama

By entering the Gold Coast Eisteddfod you agree to abide by the rules and regulations as outlined in this Syllabus. Gold Coast Eisteddfod's public liability does not comprehensively cover injury to performers, therefore individuals and schools must ensure that they are adequately covered whilst performing or otherwise enter at their own risk. By agreeing, you automatically grant permission for digital images or footage to be used for promotional or marketing purposes and/or social media.

If you do not agree please advise the Eisteddfod office in writing.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the Gold Coast Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter.
- 2. **Entries close: May 5, 2023, unless sold out prior.** Please submit entries as early as possible due to entry numbers being limited. Payment will be by PayPal or direct debit.
- 3. Enter online at www.goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office mail@goldcoasteisteddfod.com.au
- 4. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GCE accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 5. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GCE.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, any item may be performed once only by a competitor and an entrant may only enter once in each section.
- 7. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the adjudicator will penalise.
- 8. GCE reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 9. GCE reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should it be deemed necessary.
- 10. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
- 13. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded).

- 14. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and change room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones, cameras and video recorders are prohibited in HOTA Theatre 1, Broadbeach Cultural Precient (excluding Younng People with Disability), A.B Paterson College Dawn Lang Performing Arts Centre & GLOW Church. In other venues, where there is no official operator, private recording is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of competitor on stage. No photography during a performance.
- 15. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify GCE as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.
- 16. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance. Due to this, it is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.
- 17. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$50 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and their eligibility to appear in any age grouping, GCE reserves the right to request a copy of the birth certificate of that competitor. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered.
- 18. Every care will be taken for competitors' safety, but GCE will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 19. Teachers please note there will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GCE.
- 20. GCE has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 21. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified.
- 22. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GCE on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
- 23. All medals & trophies are provided by the Gold Coast Eisteddfod.
- 24. Competitors must change in their designated area No public area to be used for changing.
- 25. No house curtain.
- 26. Only hand held props i.e. the dancer must be able to carry the prop in their hands (chairs / benches will be allowed) No props that cause debris ie. talc powder, confetti, glitter or popping of balloons is allowed. No helium balloons.
- 27. For any tapping, all members must have taps on shoes. No tapping on backing track.
- 28. For aggregates, in the event of a tie, a countback on placings will determine the winner.
- 29. No handheld microphones to be used in any sections.
- 30. Open Age Groups may include semi-professional, professional, ex-professional and teachers.
- 31. Any competitor who attends group dance classes for less than 15 hours per week may perform in the sections which have the classification <u>non full-time students</u>.
- 32. No competitor is to perform anywhere other than the stage area. This includes entry, exits and absolutely NO jumping off the stage.
- 33. Inappropriate and suggestive movement, costuming and /or obscene language is not permitted. The adjudicator may comment and/or penalise
- 34. Music must be uploaded via GCE system prior to event. All competitors must have at least one back up on USB (1 track) or similar device.
- 35. Groups minimum of 4 competitors.
- 36. Age as at January 1, 2023. All competitors in group items must be within the stated age limits i.e. 12 years & under no competitor may be more than 12 years old.
- 37. Complimentary Teachers Passes will be allocated to all dance studios who have entered group competition. These can be collected from GCE Information Desk.

- 38. Studios must have two delegated marshals for each group who will assist in the flow of the competition and supervise entering and exiting their performance. Competitors in groups must be supervised at all times.
- 39. 'Holding' rooms (dressing rooms) are assigned to studios. There will be no access to 'holding' room for parents. This area is limited to performers, teachers and delegated marshals. Bags are to be kept to a minimum. Public areas are not to be utilised as change rooms. All studios will be advised arrival times prior.
- 40. Studio heads & teachers must adhere to safe dance practice.
- 41. There is to be NO rehearsing on the stage or in corridors or passageways.
- 42. For competitor safety please do not choreograph items requiring group members to exit one side of the stage re-entering from the other side. If absolutely essential, crossover must be used. All groups are to enter stage via Prompt and exit OP.
- 43. The use of hairspray etc is a health hazard. These must be used with great care in a well-ventilated area preferably in the open air or prior to arrival.
- 44. Competitors Passes are compulsory for all dance group performers and must be visible at all times, unless performing Dance Studio competitor pass = \$15 per person can be used on all 8 group days including Primary & Secondary School days. Primary & Secondary School dance groups = \$10 per person. Teachers may contact the office prior to the event to make arrangements for purchasing passes in bulk. Individual passes will be available online and can be collected at the venues.
- 45. Studios are responsible for keeping their dressing space clean and rubbish free. Food & drink is not permitted in dressing areas apart from bottled water. Dressing rooms left in an untidy state will have a cleaning fee of \$200 charged to the offending studios.
- 46. While in the dressing rooms we ask you to respect other people's costumes, belongings and space.
- 47. No limit on competitor appearances in any one group section.
- 48. Studios must carry a first aid kit with their group and be prepared to assist competitors who choose to dance with a pre-existing injury.
- 49. Must state the number of performers in groups when entering important information for GCE planning.

MUSIC

Music must be uploaded via GCE system prior to event. All competitors must have at least one back up on USB (1 track) or similar device.
